



Series II Fuel/Water Separator Redesign



Baldwin Filters has redesigned its Series II line of fuel filter/water separators. Prior to this design change, the construction of this family of filters included a metallic housing. The new construction utilizes a high-strength polymer housing.

New Design Features

- Tough, durable engineered polymer material, used for the housing, withstands even the worst application environments.
- Conductive, polymer material designed to dissipate static electricity build-up.
- Structural requirements met for all intended applications.
- Consistently tested to several hundred thousand cycles in hydrodynamic impulse testing at application pressures with no leaks.
- Environmentally friendly components (with exception of media pleat clip and wave spring).
- Raised keys eliminated for universal fit on multiple fuel bases.
- Wave spring provides installation resistance for proper fit.

The Series II part numbers will not change. The new style filters will be placed into stock as the old style filters are used up.

NOTE: This change does not affect the marine version products, BF7949-DM and BF7971-DM. These filters will continue to use the metallic housing design.
